
## POTENTIAL HOUSING DEVELOPMENT SITES

Land promoted by landowners to York and Selby Councils for potential housing development



- 1. Black dotted line is York/Selby administrative boundary
- 2. Land outlined in red: Site subject to previous village consultation in 2008. This has been assessed by Selby (2011/12 SHLAA) as suitable to provide housing in years 6-10 of the Plan period.
- 3. Land outlined in blue and shaded brown: Site subject to a previous village consultation as a potential affordable housing site. This has been assessed by Selby (2011/12 SHLAA) as suitable to provide housing years 11-15 of the Plan period.
- 4. Land outlined in blue: Site now also submitted to Selby in last call for sites as available and suitable for development.
- 5. Land outlined in green: Site now submitted to York in last call for sites as available and suitable for development. The land hatched green is now proposed as a strategic housing allocation in York's LDF. The land coloured yellow is proposed as Safeguarded land for future housing development. This is the proposal currently out for consultation in York (Site 183) on which views are sought. This was discussed at the recent Annual Parish Meeting.

All of these sites are still being promoted by the landowners as available for consideration as potential housing sites. None have been withdrawn.
